SERVICE FOR PEOPLE LIVING WITH PPA (Primary Progressive Aphasia)

We continue to offer online support to couples and families living with PPA.

Assessments over zoom are offered free. Depending on need, support after assessment might take the form of a one off information and advice session, a 4 session course of Conversation Partner Training, or introduction to someone living with a similar communication difficulty. Sessions are led by a specialist Speech and Language Therapist.

CHARGES - Dyscover is a charity and our services are subsidised by grants. We ask for a contribution from members. Our charges range from £13.50 a session for online post stroke aphasia groups, to £200 for an individualised 4 session course of Conversation Partner Training with a specialist Speech and Language Therapist.
